

DePaul University Neighborhood Parking Program

DePaul University provides a limited number of permits – free of charge – for evening and weekend on-campus parking to eligible residential neighbors through its Neighborhood Parking Program.

To participate in this program, residents must live within the following boundaries: Altgeld (north) – Armitage (south) – Halsted (east) – Wayne (west). Proof of residency is required at the time of registration, and participation is limited to one permit per household.

Through this program, parking is available in student surface lots A, L and F and in the Clifton garage from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. on Monday through Friday, and all day on Saturday and Sunday.

A special DePaul "Area Resident" parking hang tag is required to park in all DePaul facilities. To enter the Clifton parking garage, residents also need a DePaul access card. Please note that a parking permit does not guarantee an available space in the parking facilities.

Parking permits, hang tags and access cards are available at the DePaul University Parking Services office, 2320 N. Kenmore, room 177, which is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday. Parking permits are valid for the academic year, September 1 through August 31.
